#### Scheme - Pragati Scholarship Scheme (AICTE) - Only for Girls

- Girl students studying in institute approved by All India Council of Technical Education and pursuing Diploma level and undergraduate level education.
- Scholarships are offered to 624 candidates pursuing diploma courses and 553 candidates pursuing undergraduate courses according to quota assigned for Maharashtra State and the merit list generated by central Govt.
- Annual income of parents of girl students should be Rs. 8.00 lakh or less.

# Scheme - Saksham Scholarship Scheme (AICTE) - For Specially Abled Student - For All Category Student

- Specially abled student studying in All India Council of Technical Education (AICTE) approved institutes and pursuing diploma and undergraduate degree education

- Annual income of parents of students should be Rs. 8.00 lakh or less.

# Scheme - Swanath Scholarship Scheme (AICTE) - For Orphans, wards of parents died due to Covid-19, wards of Armed Forces and Central Paramilitary Forces martyred in action (Shaheed)

- The candidate should be currently studying in the AICTE Approved institutions and pursuing diploma and degree education in regular mode.
- The Student should be orphans or wards of parents died due to Covid-19 or wards of Armed Forces or Central Paramilitary Forces martyred in action (Shaheed).
- Scholarship is given to the first 1000 students pursuing degree education and first 1000 students pursuing diploma education from all over the nation as per merit list.
- Annual income of parents of students should be Rs. 8.00 lakh or less.

# Scholarship for Higher Education in Foreign Countries for the Meritorious Students

#### **Important Conditions -**

- > Candidate must have got the admission on merit in the First Year of the Full-Time Post graduation Degree, Postgraduate Diploma or PhD in the academic Institution/ University abroad having THE(Times Higher Education) / or QS (Quaqurelli Symonds) World Ranking within 200
- Unconditional Offer letter from Foreign University
- > Total annual income of Parents of the candidates / family from all sources and including candidates income, if employed, for the previous financial year, shall not be more than 8 Lakh.
- > Candidate and Candidate's mother and father or guardian shall be citizen of India and Domicile of Maharashtra state
- > The candidate admitted in Post graduation must have age below 35 years and for PhD course must have age below 40 years.
