



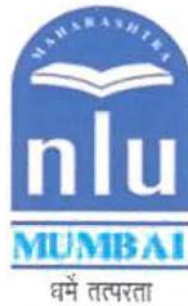

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AUDITOR'S REPORT

Report on the Financial Statements of **Maharashtra National Law University, Mumbai**.

Opinion

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of **Maharashtra National Law University, Mumbai**, which comprise the balance sheet as of 31st March 2025, and the income statement for the year then ended 31st March 2025, and notes to the financial statements, including a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.

An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statements.

Other Matter Paragraphs

1. The University has implemented gratuity schemes in the year 2022-23 for staff who are on payroll. However, an actuarial valuation for the gratuity liability has not been conducted. This raises concerns about the potential underestimation of the liability for gratuity payments. It is recommended that the University undergo an actuarial valuation to accurately assess the gratuity liability and ensure appropriate provisions are made for future gratuity payments.

Accounting period 1st April 2024 to 31st March 2025

1. MNLU Mumbai was established through a notification dated March 20, 2014, issued by the Government of Maharashtra under the Maharashtra National Law University Act, 2014. The financial year covers the period from April 1, 2024, to March 31, 2025. Previous year figures have been appropriately reclassified, as required.
2. **Basis for Preparation of Accounts.**

The accounts are prepared under the Historical Cost convention unless otherwise stated and generally on the Accrual Method of Accounting. The Financial Statements are prepared on the basis of revised Formats and Schedules of Financial Statements for Educational Institutions prescribed by the Department of Higher Education, Ministry of HRD, Government of India.

3. **Revenue Recognition.**

Tuition fees collected separately for each semester is accounted on accrual basis. Interest on Saving Bank accounts are accounted on cash basis. Interest on Term Deposits with banks are accounted on accrual basis.

4. **Conversion or translation of foreign currency**

Any transactions conducted in foreign currency, if applicable, will be handled in accordance with the relevant accounting standards. Similarly, foreign contributions, if received, will be recognized in the books of account following the guidelines specified by the Foreign Contribution Regulation Act (FCRA) rules.

5. **Fixed Assets and Depreciation**

5.1 Fixed assets are recorded at their cost of acquisition, which includes expenses such as inward freight, duties, taxes, and any other direct or incidental expenses related to their acquisition, installation, and commissioning.

5.2 Assets with an individual value of Rs. 2000 or less (excluding Library Books) are categorized as small value assets. For such assets, a 100% depreciation is recorded.

5.3 Fixed assets are valued at their cost less the accumulated depreciation. Depreciation on fixed assets is calculated using the Straight Line Method, applying the following rates:

6. Stocks

All items of stationary, other stores & consumables have been accounted as revenue expenditure. Hence, closing stock of such items was not valued separately at cost on 31.03.2025.

7. Investments

The University has an investment Committee which recommends deposit of surplus in Earmarked Funds into short term and long term investments as per Financial Regulations of the University.

8. Earmarked/ Endowment Funds

The surplus generated from tuition fees and other academic receipts is allocated to earmarked funds designated for specific purposes. Each of these funds maintains a separate bank account. The surplus funds are then invested in term deposits. The interest accrued and earned on these term deposits is credited back to the respective earmarked funds.

9. Government Grants.

9.1 Government grants are recorded based on the realization principle. However, if a grant is sanctioned for release in the current financial year but is received in the subsequent financial year, it is accounted for on an accrual basis. In such cases, an equivalent amount is recognized as recoverable from the grantor.

9.2 Government grants utilized for capital expenditure, on an accrual basis, are transferred to the Corpus/Capital Fund.

9.3 Government grants intended for meeting revenue expenditure are recognized as income for the period in which they are utilized.

9.4 The salaries of regular employees and the Vice Chancellor, who hold sanctioned positions, are shown as receivable from the government until the salary grants are fully realized.

10. Income Tax.

The University has obtained registration under Section 12A of the Income Tax Act, 1961, as per the order dated May 30, 2016. Additionally, it has acquired a certificate under Section 80-G of the same Act, as per the order dated July 11, 2016.

Since the institution's income falls under the exemption provided by Section 10(23C) of the Income Tax Act, no provision for tax is made in the accounts.

5. Retirement Benefits

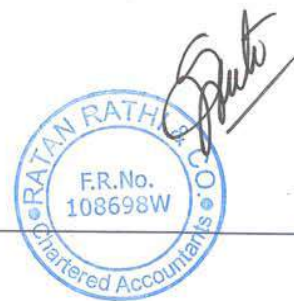

- a) It has come to our attention that the university does not maintain an electronic Fixed Asset Register and not conducting the physical verification of fixed assets. Consequently, we were unable to identify any obsolete assets. Additionally, in the previous year's recommendations, it was mentioned that the university had procured software for maintaining the Fixed Asset Register, which was expected to be updated. However, we have not observed the acquisition of such software by the university as of yet.
- b) Our observation reveals that the organization lacks an internal audit system. It is recommended that the organization should implement an internal audit system in accordance with Para No. 6.4 of the University Financial Regulations 2015. This will help ensure effective internal controls and enhance overall financial governance.

It is recommended that the University rectify these discrepancies in accordance with the prescribed accounting policy and compliance with reporting standards.
