From The Vice-Chancellor's Desk...

I am delighted to contribute to Savitribai Phule Pune University's 73rd Annual Report. The University is well known as 'Hometown of Education' for its excellence in Education, Innovation and Research Development. We at Savitribai Phule Pune University aim at becoming a vibrant knowledge center for students from across the globe. The collaborative efforts of the highly qualified teaching faculty, efficient administration and dynamic pool of students are helping the University to grow in all dimensions. The University has secured A+ rank in NAAC. It is also ranked eleventh in the National Institutional Ranking Framework. In the QS world ranking 2023 the university has been ranked in the bracket 541-550 amongst the global applications. The university has been ranked at number eight in ATAL ranking.

In the past year, the university has started an initiative of 'Degree Plus', through which more than 300 international standard courses are offered to all the students in addition to their academic degrees. Some of these courses are free and some are available at a reasonable cost.

During the last year, the university has signed several MoUs to establish collaborative connections with various national and international institutes, mainly focusing on the research on basic social issues, academic exchange, workshops and to provide students an opportunity to expand their knowledge. Taking a step towards the implementation of National Education Policy 2020 SPPU recently signed 5 MoU with American educational institutions.

SPPU is taking keen interest in implementation of New Education Policy 2020 and has taken major initiatives for the prompt and effective implementation of NEP 2020.

Universities are said to be the mirror of society. As a social responsibility, the university has also taken up RT-PCR testing project during covid. Minister of state for health and family welfare of India Dr. Bharti Pawar also visited and appreciated this project. The university has participated in the research on the medicinal plant 'Ashwagandha' of the Ministry of AYUSH. The university also organized a program 'Lokshahi Gappa' along with Maharashtra State Election office.

A 'Science Park' has been started in a separate building to give students experience of science in their school life. We gave the 'Innovative e Content Award' to the professors for creating e educational material. Museums of history, anthropology and cartoon art were also started in the university in the same year. A unique initiative 'Heritage Walk' is also being started by the university. The professors of the university have come together and prepared the development report of Sindhudurg district.

SPPU has got the honour of organising the competition of Maharashtra state Inter University Invention Research convention (Avishkar) 2023.

The union Ministry has shortlisted SPPU, the heritage of Pune to be part of G20. First G20 infrastructure working group delegates visited SPPU for a plantation programme followed by a high level workshop on 'Financing Cities of Tomorrow'.

The contribution of the university in the field of education, social and sports is the collective success of all the officials, staff, professors and students here. In the future, the university aims at achieving even bigger milestones and it is the responsibility of all of us to take this university, which is running in the name of Savitribai, to greater heights on the world stage, I believe that we will complete it together.

From The Pro-Vice-Chancellor's Desk...

I am delighted to have the opportunity of interacting with everyone on the occasion of the 73rd Annual Report of Savitribai Phule Pune University. The last two years were very difficult and nightmarish years in our lives due to the Corona pandemic. But we have been overcoming this difficult situation and doing community-oriented work and are restoring the fractured state.

Revival of the impaired condition of education is a big challenge for us as a university. After the two-year disaster of Corona, the universities and colleges have been facing a new challenge of blending both the dynamic nature of education and the implementation of the new educational policy. To meet this challenge, the university is constantly taking many reflective, comprehensive and well-timed decisions.

During the year, we have emphasized on skill-based curriculum, prioritizing the issues of employment, regular classroom teaching and reinstation. Moreover, the 'Choice Based Credit System' has enabled students to pursue courses in their field of interest. Also, the policy of providing courses in SWAYAM has been decided. Many new courses have been started collaborating with the innovative (start-up) industries as a solution to the problems faced due to unemployment. Three vocational degree courses have also been launched through the Skill Development Center, in which students are given "on-the-job-training" in the course 'B Voc in Retail Management' through an agreement with Maruti Suzuki.

The university has also established a Smart Training and Innovation Center (STIC) in collaboration with 'Pimpri Chinchwad Smart City Limited' and has started many new technology related courses. Some prominent examples of this initiative are Blended course launched with the University of Melbourne, Certificate Course in the Pedagogy of Child Education for teachers, MoUs with many organizations and companies.

The National Education Policy was announced in 2020. Due to the Covid pandemic, it was difficult to implement it completely. In order to implement this policy widely at the college level, the university has taken the initiative to conduct many workshops, seminars, symposium etc. during this year. The effective implementation of the NEP has been started by introducing blended courses and 'Liberal Education' curriculum. Also, by establishing 'Start-up Innovation Cell' in more than 250 colleges, students have been provided an opportunity to take on innovative projects. Along with that, the university has also started working on internationalization of higher education, academic credit bank, four-year degree course plan etc.

During this time, the University has built a world-class, state-of-the-art sports complex in the name of wrestler Khashaba Jadhav in an area of about twenty-seven acres. Seven and a half lakh students affiliated to the university will be benefited from this sports complex. Since this year is the 'Amrut Mahostav' (75 years) year of independence, the university has undertaken many social activities during the year. The university registered the photo record of individuals holding the national flag in the Guinness Book of World Records as a part of the national initiative 'Har Ghar Tiranga'.

Under the 'Ayush Apke Dwar' initiative 75,000 saplings have been distributed to the citizens. A batch of NCC has been started on the University campus for 100 students.

During this period, the university has excelled in teaching and research at the national and international levels and has gone up by 50 numbers securing the rank in the range of the '500 to 550' group of 'QS' global rankings. Moreover, we are proud to announce that in "World Ranking 2023" (WHE Ranking 23) we have jumped up 200 places from 800 to 1000 to "601 to 800" stage.

With a view to speeding up the administration, a separate cell for autonomous colleges, a separate cell for implementing the new education policy and coordinating all the units have also been established.

This year as well, as many as 15 researchers from the university have achieved the top position in the list of researchers of Stanford University, inscribing the research status of the university at the global level. I appreciate and congratulate all the researchers.

Considering the time-to-time crises as an opportunity rather than a crisis, the university has explored many new avenues so far. In this journey, of course, professors, researchers, administrative officers and staff and students are at the center. Owing to the contribution of all these, the university has attained a prominent position. In the future, Indian higher education is undergoing drastic changes due to the new education policy. Considering this as a great opportunity, the university has started a vigorous implementation planning and changes in the working system with the coordination and participation of all the entities.

It is hoped that with the new changes, the university will succeed in creating and catering a generation with noble thoughts and values for nation building while fulfilling its social responsibility, helping to become self-reliant.

About University

Savitribai Phule Pune University (Formerly, University of Pune) has always been at the forefront of new, evolving paradigms, which involve new thought processes. Savitribai Phule Pune University, one of the premier Universities in India, is located in the North-Western part of the city of Pune in picturesque green surroundings sprawling over 411 acres. The University is symbolically identified with the Main Building which is a monumental building with a beautiful architecture. It was once the summer residence of the Governor of Bombay during the British regime. Built in 1864, the Main Building was considered to be ahead of its times in terms of architecture. The 80-foot flag tower has been described as a 'Victorian rendering of an Italian campanile'.



The University is one of the largest and prestigious Universities in the world with more than 7.0 lakh students. The university houses 49 academic departments under 4 academic streams, each of which has its own separate building running a total of 194 academic programmes.

The University campus has the capacity to provide accommodation to 2,349 male and female students with separate residential facilities for international students, teachers and staff. The University runs a chain of refectory, hostel mess and canteens on the campus.

1.0 Governance & Best Practices

The University has always nurtured a vision consistent with its rich traditions and has followed a new path of development. The principal focus of the University has been to facilitate learning and scholarship all the way up to the current frontiers of knowledge, research, technology and innovations. It has always helped to address problems and find opportunities in the industry/society alongwith entrepreneurship that generates wealth in the society.



Excellence

1.1 QS World University Ranking :

'QS World University Ranking 2023' has been a highly regarded programme for several years. In accordance with the ranks released on June 8, 2022, SPPU secured a rank in the 541-550 category, which is higher than 591 – 600, its previous ranking category. A total of 1,422 educational institutes registered and participated and 41 Indian educational institutions were selected.





1.2 Times Higher Education ASIA Ranking :

The Times Higher Education ASIA Ranking 2022 was recently announced wherein Savitribai Phule Pune University secured the 201-250th position among the top 616 global educational institutions.

1.3 University National Ranking

Savitribai Phule Pune University is one of the most academically sound universities in India marching towards Global Ranking. As per MHRD's National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF), the University is ranked twelfth. Savitribai Phule Pune University is the only University in Maharashtra to achieve this status and is one of the top five state Universities in the country.

1.4 ATAL Ranking of Institutions :

Savitribai Phule Pune University participated in ARIIA for the first time in 2021 and was ranked eighth amongst Central Universities/CFTIs and other Institutes of National Importance. It is the only State University in Maharashtra to feature in the list.

1.5 NAAC Accreditation :

Savitribai Phule Pune University was re-accredited (Third Cycle) with A+ Grade in March 2017, with a CGPA of 3.60, by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), an autonomous institution of the University Grants Commission. This is the highest CGPA achieved by any University in the state of Maharashtra.



1.6 University with Potential for Excellence (UPE) :

Savitribai Phule Pune University has been recognized by University Grants Commission as University with potential for Excellence. The university has introduced modern ICT based methods of teaching, learning and evaluation for achieving excellence in teaching and research.

1.7 Member of International Ballistics Society (IBS):

Savitribai Phule Pune University is the first Indian University to become a member of the International Ballistics Society (IBS) with an aim to improve and promote the Science of Ballistics. Earlier the Defence and Development Organization (DRDO) was the only Indian member of the IBS.



1.8 Graded Autonomy:

Graded Autonomy- Rank 4th
NIRF - Twelfth Rank

Savitribai Phule Pune University stood fourth in the category of **Graded Autonomy** granted by the UGC (Category I). Among all the higher educational institutes of India, SPPU is the only State University selected.

The University has signed various memorandums of understanding [MoUs] with universities from Asia, Europe, Australia and America. As a part of this programme, we are now associated with UNESCO IHE Delft, The Netherlands, and Unity Knowledge LLP, Pune, India, for Water Education, Training and Capacity building. SPPU has signed an MoU with WuFeng University, Taiwan, to start new courses on Disaster Management and National Security. The University aims to develop a Fire Training Module with the help of WuFeng University.

2.0 Centre for Innovation, Incubation & Enterprise (CIIE) :

Centre for Innovation, Incubation & Enterprise (CIIE) was established as per Maharashtra Public University Act, 2016, and is engaged in promoting innovation, entrepreneurship and building the startup Eco System.

Centre for Innovation, Incubation and Linkages also initiated a course on 'PG Diploma in Innovation & New Venture Management' in partnership with Entrepreneurship Development Institute of India, Ahmedabad. The course commenced this year.

Savitribai Phule Pune University is supporting colleges to develop the culture of innovation. 340 colleges have set up startup innovation cells so far. It conducts regular Faculty Development Programmes for Colleges on 'How to run a Startup Innovation Cell'.

The university has initiated a platform to deliver online courses in partnership with some of the best universities worldwide. Harvard Business School Online has signed an MoU with the University to offer courses at a special price for Students and Alumni. Services like Amazon web services, Simplilearn, Edx, Deakin University Australia, and a few courses developed in-house are being offered at concessional rates to all SPPU students. The objective of this degree plus platform is to ensure the employability of the students and to encourage them to take these courses along with their degree courses.

3.0 SPPU Research Park Foundation (RPF):

SPPU Research Park Foundation (SPPU-RPF) is a section 8 company fully owned by Savitribai Phule Pune University (SPPU). It was set up to facilitate and assist entrepreneurs directly and indirectly with infrastructure support, laboratory space, special instrument and equipment facilities in certain areas, know-how and technical support, information support, business mentoring support, administration and market support and also to provide avenues for researchers and technologists for taking up laboratory research in various academic and research institutes. SPPU-RPF's objective is to bring the MSME industry for co-location, conduct entrepreneurship training, incubate startups, conduct Industry – academia meetings for the benefit of students and faculty, attract leading industries to establish R&D centres in SPPU and to start generating revenue towards self-sufficiency.





Established in January 2019, The Research Park is promoting research-based entrepreneurship, offering incubation space for start-ups as well as providing co-location facilities to the industry for Research and Development. Startups from Centre for Innovation, Incubation and Enterprise are incubated at SPPU – RPF. It is a 'gateway' to take SPPU research to the industry, in particular, and society, in general.

4.0 Centre for Intelligent System (CIS) :

The Department of Technology's 'Centre for Intelligent System (CIS)' under the initiative of Rashtriya Uchhatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) is located in 4000 sq feet area and has 8 Indian patents filed so far and has 7 journal papers under the centre and is working closely with customers.



5.0 Design Innovation Centre :



Design Innovation Centre has been initiated and funded by the Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) under the scheme 'National Initiative for setting up of Design Innovation Centres'. The Design Innovation Centre (DIC) has been created to establish a network with the industries, end users, farmers, etc. so as to understand their problems and provide solutions. It serves as a link between Savitribai Phule Pune University Faculty, Spoke Centres and Industry partners. The DIC is a consortium of research faculty and students in the campus and at the Spoke Centres. Thus, with the active participation of the University and the Spoke Centres, various innovative ideas are being envisioned and executed leading to the development of a number of prototypes for the end-users. This will also help to generate funds for the sustenance and continuation of DIC activities.

6.0 Educational Multimedia Research Centre (EMMRC)



Educational Multimedia Research Centre, Savitribai Phule Pune University, was established in 1984 by the University Grants Commission to create Educational Television Programmes for Higher Education. Later on, as technology grew and the need for change was felt, the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, took an initiative in 2012, under the NME-ICT Project, in developing syllabus-based e-Content programmes for 89 under-graduate students. Again in 2017, the ministry took

another initiative in developing Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs) for all levels from school to higher education. This Centre was given the task of developing MOOCs for under-graduate subjects. In June 2019, the Centre was also given the task of developing the post-graduate courses.

Under this, the Ministry developed the SWAYAM Portal. 'Study Webs of Active-Learning for Young Aspiring Minds' (SWAYAM) is the indigenous ICT based platform for hosting Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs) developed under the aegis of NME-ICT. An initiative of the Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Government of India, MOOCs supplement the formal education system in the country from high school to higher education offering courses based on curriculum, continuing education and skill. Since 2017, the Centre has developed about twenty-three under-graduate MOOCs.

Till date, the Centre has offered a total of 24 UG courses to students starting from June 2018.

E-content such as: e-PG-Pathshala, CEC (under e-PG-Pathshala CEC (Under Graduate) SWAYAM other MOOCs platform NPTEL/NMEICT/any other Government initiatives & institutional (Learning Management System (LMS) etc. have been developed by the teaching faculty.

7.0 E-content Development & Learning Innovation Centre

The university has developed a full-fledged modern 'e-content Development & Learning Innovation Centre' on campus. The university has also created many e-content modules and established digital classrooms for an effective teaching learning process. University has a fully functional state-of-the-art e-content creation studio which facilitates teachers to record their sessions using various IT tools in High-Definition Video format. Modern technologies are extensively used by the University faculties for lecture preparation. Sessions can be broadcasted live online to students of affiliated colleges with a mechanism to receive queries online. The University has developed several 'Digital Classrooms' for effective and efficient delivery of lectures.



The University has teamed up with several universities in the world to deliver online courses. Harvard Business School Online has signed an MoU with the University to offer courses at a special price for students and alumni. Services like Amazon web services, Simplilearn, Edx, Deakin University, Australia, and a few courses developed in-house are being offered at concessional rates to all SPPU students. The objective of this degree plus platform is to ensure the employability of the students and to encourage them to take these courses along with their degree courses.

Savitribai Phule Pune University has collaborated with Pune Smart City (PCSCCL) to offer programmes under 'Smart Training & Innovation Centre (STIC) aligning itself to the industry 4.0 in the domains of manufacturing & technology.

ICCR and SPPU have come together to launch an ambitious initiative titled Universalization of Indian Traditional Knowledge System (UITKS) for allowing the global community an insight into the Indian traditions in the form of a certificate course.



The Learning Management System (LMS) developed by the University for teaching and for conducting examinations is being extensively used by various departments in the campus & by a few affiliated colleges, therefore, benefitting thousands of students & faculty members. University initiated this activity to support the colleges and campus departments and capacity building for more than 2000 faculty members was done by e-CDLIC. A total of 2500 courses were mapped and content was created for students to learn in an asynchronous mode.

8.0 Automation and e-Governance

The University has a pervasive presence in three large districts of Maharashtra. As a part of our consistent endeavors to maintain high academic quality and improve governance, the University has adopted various ICT based processes focused on:

- Enhanced efficiency & effectiveness of processes
- Better accountability & responsiveness of services
- Ensuring inclusiveness & equity by ease of access thereby bringing in more transparency & participation in the system.

3.0 Competitive Examination Centre

SPPU has always been on the forefront in providing training and support to aspirants who need to prepare and compete in Administrative Services and other State Level & Private Sector Services through this centre. The following are the achievements:

The Centre:

- The centre organises UPSC preparations, webinars regularly alongwith Counselling sessions.
- For UPSC/MPSC students, an e-library/digital library was started which now includes 215 textbooks & journals. Remote access is given to all the students.
- Mock Interview Session for UPSC Civil Services Examination and MPSC State Services Examination was held on April 19, 2022.
- Sessions that include news and book review sessions are conducted regularly by experts.
- An 'Induction Programme' was organized as a part of the UGC-UPSC/MPSC Coaching Programme during April 4-7, 2022, in which a total of 11 students passed.



4.0 Right to Information Office (RTI) :

The RTI office at the University worked actively on all the proposals received under the Right to Information Act, 2005, for the period July 1, 2021, to June 30, 2022. SPPU received 642 applications out of which 638 have been resolved. Only 39 applications are pending and have received 71 first appeal applications out of which all first appeal applications have been resolved. There were only 3 pending first appeal applications till June 30, 2022.

5.0 Eligibility Section :

The 'Eligibility Section' provided Eligibility Numbers to 2,74,453 students through the online eligibility process. The section also provided 15,594 Migration Certificates to the students willing to take admission in other Universities.

6.0 Reservation Cell :

The 'Reservation Cell' has issued remarks on 2,436 teacher approvals forwarded by the Academic Section as per the reservation policy.

7.0 Grievances Cell :

From July 1, 2021, to June 30, 2022, a total of 84 new complaints were filed, of which, the Grievances Committee resolved 51 complaints.

11. National Service Scheme :

- As per the directions of the Regional Directorate, Govt of India, SLO, Higher and Technical Education, International Yoga Day is celebrated in various colleges of Pune, Ahmednagar and Nashik Districts. On the occasion of Yoga Day, awareness about Yoga and Asanas was created through social media and through online lectures by eminent personalities.
- During Covid-19, under the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, programme volunteers, officers and colleges arranged presentations and competitions. As a part of this board, online webinars, seminars, patriotism-diaries, patriotism-thought books, televising competitions, state competition festivals were organized for the students.
7. As per a letter from the State Liaison Officer, Department of Higher and Technical Education, the Indian team participating in the Tokyo Olympics were to ensure that all programme officers re-tweet on ianuragthakur, follow the Twitter account and send messages, videos, etc., for encouragement. All volunteers were encouraged to create messages, posters and videos and upload them on Twitter, Instagram, YouTube and Facebook.



8. As per the directives received from the Youth and Sports Ministry and the Regional Directorate of RASEO, Government of India, Pune, a 'Swachhata Fortnight' was implemented from August 1-15, 2021. Accordingly, with a view to creating public awareness about cleanliness, various activities were organized in Raseyo College, both online and in person, after adhering to the Covid-19 restrictions. This activity was publicised using Facebook, WhatsApp and other social media.
9. The Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India, New Delhi, and the Regional Director, RASEO Regional Directorate, Government of India, Pune, suggested the celebration of 75 years of India's Independence-'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav' through various activities. Accordingly, on August 13, 2021, a programme was organized at some of the historical sites symbolizing the freedom struggle. Fit India Freedom Run 2.0 was organized in every district. In Pune district, on August 13, 2021, the event was organized at Aga Khan Palace, Pune, and Shivram Hari Rajguru's birthplace, Rajgurunagar, Khed. Also, On August 14, 2021, the activity was carried out at a historical place in Ahmednagar district and on September 25, 2021, the event was held in Nashik district.
10. The Department of Higher and Technical Education, Maharashtra State, NSS Cell, Mumbai, awards outstanding volunteers, programme officers, colleges and universities at the state and national level every year. The Maharashtra government announced the following awards for volunteers, programme officers, colleges and universities who excelled during the academic year 2020-21:
Best college – Anekant Education Society's Tuljaram Chaturchand Arts, Commerce and Science College, Baramati;
Best Programme officer – Dr. Vilas Kardile, Tuljaram Chaturchand Arts, Commerce and Science College, Baramati;
Best Volunteer – Miss Rajshri Mane, Vidya Pratishthan's Kamalnayan Bajaj Institute of Engineering and Technology, Baramati.
11. On the occasion of 75 years of India's Independence, Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India, New Delhi, and as per the directives of the Regional Director, NSS Regional Directorate, Government of India, Pune, 75 years of India's Independence-'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav' was celebrated through various activities. Accordingly, Savitribai Phule Pune University, National Service Scheme and Department of Political Science organized an inaugural lecture on Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav on August 25, 2021, at 11 a.m., at Sant Dnyaneshwar Auditorium in the online mode. Hon. Arif Mohammad Khan, Hon'ble Governor, State of Kerala, was present as the chief guest and Hon. Vice Chancellor, Dr. Nitin Karmalkar, and Hon. Pro Vice-Chancellor, Dr. N. S. Umrani, Dr. Prafulla Pawar-Registrar of Savitribai Phule Pune University, Hon. Mr. Rajesh Pandey, Management Council Member, Hon. Dr. Sanjay Chakane,

Prof. Mangesh Kulkarni, Head of the Department of Political Science, were present for the lecture. It was conducted in the presence of Prabhakar Desai, Director, National Service Scheme, Savitribai Phule Pune University.

12. Every year, a state level Republic Day parade is conducted in Mumbai and a National Republic Day parade is organized in Delhi. Savitribai Phule Pune University and National Service Scheme jointly arranged a selection camp for State level Republic Day Parade on September 17, 2022, at Pune, and September 16, 2022, at Ahmednagar and Nashik districts. 150 volunteers participated in the camp. Five girls and four boys were selected and they, along with Prof. Shalini Ghumare, participated in West Zone pre-Republic Day parade camp at Hyderabad during November 20 to 29, 2021.
13. The victory in the 1971 Indo-Pak war and the independence of Bangladesh is celebrated every year. The year 2021 marks the 50th anniversary of Victory Day. On this occasion, Shri Narendra Modi, Prime Minister of India, handed over the Vijay Jyoti so that it reaches various corners of the country. Between October 1-30, the Vijay Jyoti was in Pune. Vijay Jyoti arrived at 4 pm on October 14, 2021, at Savitribai Phule Pune University and the Hon. Vice Chancellor welcomed it on this occasion along with 150 NSS Volunteers and programme officers. Also, a military dignitary, Hon. Vice-Chancellor, Hon. Pro-Vice-Chancellor and all administrative officers, Hon. Management Council Member, Hon. Adhi Sabha members, heads of departments, teaching and non-teaching staff were present for the procession.
14. Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune, National Service Scheme and Regional Blood Bank, Sassoon Hospital, Pune, in association with the backdrop of the blood drive during Covid-19, conducted a blood donation campaign on October 30, 2021, at the NSS Office, Datto Vaman Potdar Complex, Savitribai Phule Pune University. 50 students from various colleges in Pune and Pimpri-Chinchwad area participated in this blood donation drive and donated blood.
15. As directed by Regional Director, Government of India, Pune Vigilance Awareness Week was organized from October 26 to November 01, 2021. Accordingly, various activities were conducted based on the theme 'Swatantra Bharat 75: Akhandata ke Saath Atmanirbharta' in colleges. On October 31, 2021, on the occasion of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel's birthday and National Unity Day, 'National Unity Day' oath, 'National Unity Race', essay, oration, poster competition, films, documentaries, cultural programs and sports competitions were organized in the colleges on the theme of National Unity.
16. As per the directions from the University Grants Commission, the Investor Education and Protection Fund Authority under the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Government of India, is launching an Investor and Financial Literacy Campaign in coordination with the Ministry of Education, Government of India. A three-month campaign at the primary level is included in



NSS. To raise investor awareness, financial literacy in society is necessary. Therefore, NSS volunteers were imparted basic knowledge so as to be empowered in their personal lives and also to work for the financial literacy awareness among the people.

17. On behalf of the Maharashtra State Election Commission, a special brief programme for revision of electoral rolls was conducted during the period November 1-30, 2021. This included registering the name of a new voter, making corrections, etc. Also, to create electoral awareness among new voters, this campaign was publicized through Voter Literacy Clubs established at college level in order to encourage as many young voters as possible to register. Also, all the NSS volunteers of colleges were informed about this campaign.
18. According to the letter from the Regional Director, NSS Regional Directorate, Government of India, Pune, and as directed by the Assistant Programme Advisor, Ministry of Youth and Sports, Government of India, New Delhi, programmes under Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav were arranged.
19. On the occasion of Victory Week (50th anniversary of 1971 war), various activities were conducted between December 13 and 19, 2021. Also, the festival of rivers in India, National Girl Child Day-December 2021, and January 24, 2022, respectively were celebrated.
20. As per the instructions of Hon. Election Commission of India and Sub-district Election Officer, Pune, National Voters' Day was celebrated on January 25, 2022. Voter awareness clubs established in colleges arranged voting awareness programs. Each college organized a Youth Voter Utsav for students under Election Literacy Clubs. Various competitions in the form of essays, rangoli, paintings, pamphlets, poems and slogans were organized by the students to create awareness among the voters.
21. On the occasion of Swami Vivekananda Jayanti, National Service Scheme Youth Week was celebrated between January 12 and 18, 2022. During this youth week, online workshops and seminars were organized at the Savitribai Phule Pune University.
22. Colleges in Pune, Ahmednagar and Nashik Districts organized lectures on Swami Vivekananda's Thoughts and Today's Youth, Youth for Clean as well as Healthy India Campaign, Scientific Literacy Campaign, Eradication of Plastic Waste, Voter Awareness, Changing Mindset of Youth, Scientific Perspectives among Youth and Corona Awareness: My Village Corona-Free Village.
23. As per the direction of the Regional Director, Ministry of Youth and Sports, Government of India, under the programme Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav, National Girl Child Day was observed in Pune, on January 24, 2022. With the aim of sensitizing and creating public awareness about the safety of girls and Women Empowerment, Beti Bachao Beti Padhao, programmes were

arranged and Women with remarkable achievements in the field of Sports were honoured. Programmes like 'Selfie with Daughter' and 'Asha' were implemented on this day.

24. In co-ordination with the Election Commission of India, Sub-district Election Officer, Pune, National Voter's Day was celebrated on January 25, 2022. Accordingly, various activities were implemented by the colleges. Also, Savitribai Phule Pune University and National Service Scheme conducted voter oath activities for all the programme officers and NSS volunteers in Pune, Ahmednagar and Nashik districts on the occasion of National Voters' Day. Hon. Vice Chancellor, Dr. Nitin Karamalkar, Hon. Pro Vice-Chancellor, Dr. N.S. Umrani, and Chief Electoral Officer and Principal Secretary, Hon'ble Shri Shrikant Deshpande, participated and guided everybody. Programme officers and volunteers from all the three districts were present in this activity.
25. In accordance with the MoU between Savitribai Phule Pune University and Rotary India Literacy Mission, Pune, the National Service Scheme volunteers were to educate illiterate adults. Accordingly, the planning meeting and online training were organized on January 18, 2022. Programme officers and volunteers from Pune City and Pune Rural Division participated in this.
26. Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj has always been a source of inspiration for India. June 6, 1674, is observed as Shivrajyabhishek Din or the Coronation Day of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj. It was directed through a Maharashtra government circular to celebrate June 6, 2022, as Shivswarajyabhishek Day. Hence the same day was celebrated in colleges with the participation of NSS programme officers and volunteers. Accordingly, the following activities were implemented in the colleges on that day viz. salutations were made to the statue of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj alongwith the singing of the Maharashtra Geet and the National Anthem. The following activities were also undertaken:
 1. Organisation of lectures on Shivacharitra by various dignitaries
 2. Exhibitions of photographs /short films on forts
 3. Essay competition, elocution competition, Powada singing competition, sports competitions
 4. Shiv Jyot rally with a social message
27. In collaboration with Savitribai Phule Pune University, Department of National Service scheme and Nashik Municipal Corporation, Nashik, 'Har Ghar Dastak' Campaign-2 under Covid-19 vaccination was implemented from June 01 to July 31, 2022, in Nashik Municipal Corporation area. Accordingly, all the colleges affiliated to the National Service Scheme in Nashik city co-operated with Nashik Municipal Corporation by participating in this vaccination campaign under Covid-19 Vaccination 'Har Ghar Dastak' Mission-2.



28. According to the letter issued by the State Liaison Officer under Mazi Vasundhara Mission and directions to organize environment awareness and cleanliness week, it is celebrated between June 7-13, 2022. Accordingly, the NSS units identified educational institutions, forts, wells, rivers, lakes, caves, historical places, government hospitals, public places, bus stations, etc., in their locality and these were cleaned by NSS volunteers. Street plays and awareness programmes were also organized by NSS volunteers on the concept of environment change and cleanliness, importance of environment and cleanliness in villages, cities, crowded places, plastic free India, solid waste management, etc.
29. On the occasion of Sant Dynaneshwar Maharaj and Sant Tukaram Maharaj Palkhi celebrations, Savitribai Phule Pune University, National Service scheme, as a part of the programme Azadi ka Amrut Mahotsav, Swachh Vari-Swastha Vari-Nirmal Vari-Harit Vari and Corona Mukti public awareness, organized a disaster management campaign and tree plantation activities and processions between June 22 and July 10, 2022. The tradition of this Dindi (procession) has been going on for the past 18 years. Awareness regarding the disinfection of public buildings and places, health survey of families, blood donation camps, taking an oath not to defecate in the open and not to spit in the open, and to educate every citizen is created through various activities. A total of 190 persons including 140 NSS volunteers and around 50 volunteers, 40 members of the teaching staff from universities across the state participated in this activity.

1.0 Grants



1. Donation/Gold Medals and Chairs :

Donation/Gold Medals and Chairs:

Savitribai Phule Pune University has around 838 donors and their Corpus as on March 31, 2022, was Rs. 72.86 crores. The University has instituted 152 Gold Medals to be awarded to the students studying in various faculties. It has 25 Chairs/Adhyasan. Out of these 23 Chairs have corpus. The Mahatma Gandhi and DRDO-ISRO Chairs are funded by Government of Maharashtra and Government of India respectively.

2. Mediclaim Policy:

The Group Mediclaim and Group Accident policy scheme is being implemented for the University Teaching and Non-Teaching employees (Government Approved, University Fund and Self-Supporting Departments, Statutory posts, Teaching & Non-Teaching Staff on contractual basis and on regular pay scale). The Mediclaim policy of the year 2021-22 was of the Floater category. 1,223 university employees and 3,467 relatives of the university employees are covered under this scheme. The sum insured under this scheme is Rs. 3 lakhs for employees and family members. University teaching and non-teaching employees serving on Government sanctioned posts, University funded posts and confirmed employees who are serving for a period of more than 20 years in self-supporting Departments, Statutory posts and Teaching & Non-Teaching Staff on contractual basis and on regular pay scale are eligible for this scheme. The University shoulders 100% of the financial responsibility of the premium for the employees and 50% in the case of relatives. Thus, 50% premium is deducted from the employees' salaries.



3. Grants from Funding Agencies :

The university is striving to be self-sufficient in the near future. It has received funds of Rs. 43.88 Crores from various funding agencies for research and other academic purposes during the period between July 1, 2021, to June 30, 2022.

Chapter 5 CENTRAL FACILITIES

1.0 Central Instrumentation Facility:



The Central Instrumentation Facility (CIF) at the Savitribai Phule Pune University was established to cater to the need of academicians and researchers, on the campus and affiliated colleges of the SPPU, in the high priority areas of research in basic sciences. This facility is extended to all the universities, academic institutes, national research institutes, defense institutes, and industries in India.

- Industries like Innovassynth Technologies India Ltd., Lupin Limited, Camlin Fine Science, OmniActive Health Technologies, Elantas Beck India Limited, Sai, Hikal, Nayam Innovations Pvt. Ltd, Avieum Life Sciences Pvt Ltd., Frerea Natural Products Solutions Pvt. Ltd, Vipanan Analytical Technologies, Knowchem Lab Pvt. Ltd., Ceva Polchem Pvt. Ltd., etc.

- b) Dental Services – A total of 1,301 patients have made use of the Dental services available in the University Health Centre D.Y. Patil Dental College, Pune.

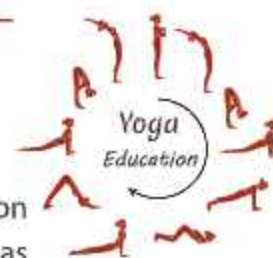
3) Medical Examination of University Hostel Students and International Students: -

4) SPECIAL FEATURES :

1) Yoga Education Centre:-

The Yoga Education Centre was started in March 2002 in collaboration with Kaivalyadham Shreeman Madhava Yoga Mandir Samiti, Lonavla. U.G.C. has



sanctioned a grant for the Yoga education centre. Separate classes are held for males & females. Four classes (two in the morning & two in the evening) are held on working days. One male & one female yoga instructor are involved in teaching yogasanas to students and employees.

ii) Counselling Centre for University staff and students.

A Counselling centre for the University staff, University Students and students from colleges was started with effect from July, 2012. Dr. Geeta Bhat - Hon. Psychiatrist and Smt. Nirupama Dastane – counsellor, visit this centre from Monday to Friday from 3.00 pm. to 4.30 pm. During the period of the report around 35 persons made use of the facility.

iii) Programme Organized in Health Centre:

1. The Health Centre, Savitribai Phule Pune University, and Pune Municipal Corporation jointly organized a Covid-19 Vaccination Centre in which 9,931 people were vaccinated upto June 30, 2022.
2. The Health Centre, Savitribai Phule Pune University, and the International Student Centre conducted a Covid-19 Vaccination programme for international students. In this year, 133 students were vaccinated.
3. Health centre, Savitribai Phule Pune University Pune, UGC - Human Development and Research Centre, Kaivalya Dham Lonaala jointly developed a Post Covid Recovery and Rehabilitation Programme. Health centre, and Health Science Department, Savitribai Phule Pune University jointly conducted Ashwagandha clinical trials of AAYUSH Mantralaya, New Delhi

5.0 Jayakar Knowledge Resource Centre

5.1 Introduction:

The library has a legacy of 72 years and has been functioning from an independent building of about 1,50,000 sq. ft. area. The activities recounted in this report demonstrate the commitment of the library staff to contributing to the fulfillment of Savitribai Phule Pune University's academic mission.



5.2 Budget Provisions:

The total budget for the year April 2021-March 2022, of the Jayakar Knowledge Centre was Rs.5,13,00,000/-. Out of this, an amount of Rs. 3,50,00,000/- was provided for the subscription of periodicals and online databases, and Rs.80,00,000/- was for the purchase of books and e-books.

5.3 Acquisitions of Reading Material:

The library has made available sufficient funds to all teaching departments which were approved by the Knowledge Resource Committee. Many scholarly print and electronic books were acquired during the period of report as per the recommendations of the heads of the departments and teachers.

5.6 Reference Service:

Reference Service is a remarkable feature of any library. During the year of the report, the Knowledge Resource Centre provided references in person, on telephone and through email. The Jayakar Knowledge Resource Centre also extends the facility of referring the library to those who are not regular members of the library. Various participants of the variety of courses conducted their study tours and visited the library. For the new entrants of the university i.e., M.A. or M.Sc. students, orientation programmes were conducted. In addition to this, assistance was provided to use OPAC, the card catalogue and to locate the reading material.

5.7 Reading and Research Facilities:

Jayakar Knowledge Resource Centre has a separate building for study purposes. Presently, four reading halls having a capacity of 160 readers each are used by students. Reading and research facilities including bibliographical aids are extended to the Heads of the Departments, University Teachers, Post-graduate students, research scholars and research workers from sister universities and institutions. A specialized reading atmosphere is provided to the research students on a selective basis. Assistance has been provided in using the online journals, open-source documents, document delivery service, documentation service and other library services. Under Document Delivery Service, the Knowledge Resource Centre receives articles from other universities. On the other hand, the Knowledge Resource Centre has sent 37 articles on request to the users who required them.

The Reading Hall was kept open on all the days of the week (including Sundays and holidays) between 7.00 a.m. - 12.00 p.m.

5.8 Jayakar Knowledge Resource Centre Portal:

The main objective behind the development of Knowledge Resource Centre portal was to provide one window access to library resources as well as free resources to all users on the campus. To achieve this objective Knowledge Resource Centre has developed an E- Resource Portal that contains information regarding online union catalogues of books, theses and serial publications. Web links are provided to various National Libraries, Open Access Resources of a variety of subjects and databases. The said portal is through the Internet and is very useful to the students, staff, researchers and general public and accessible libraries of the affiliated colleges of the University. The

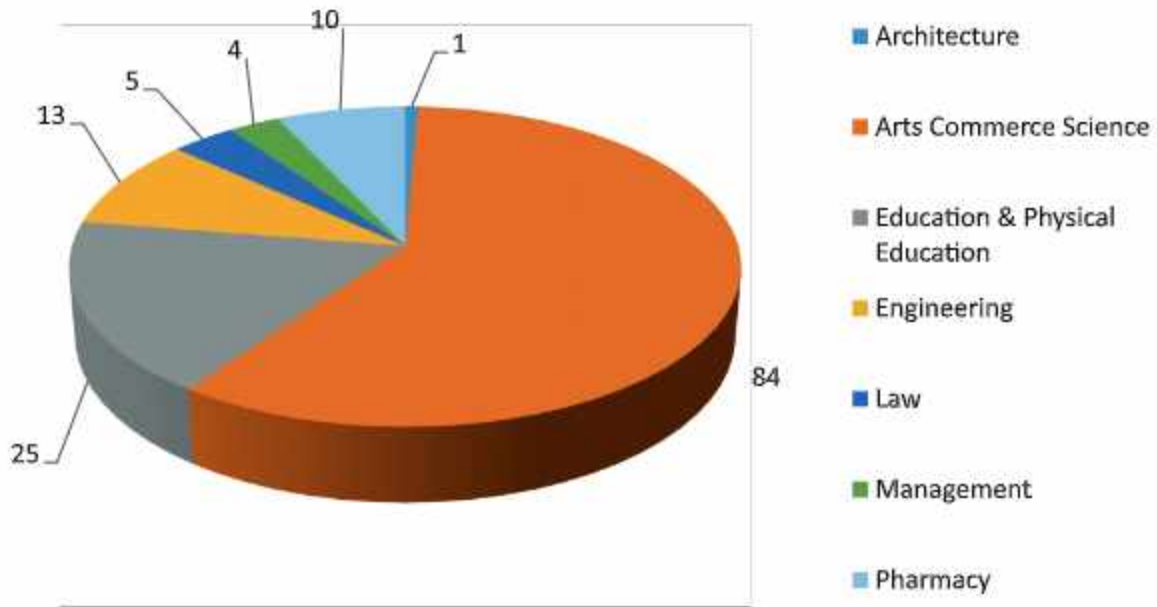

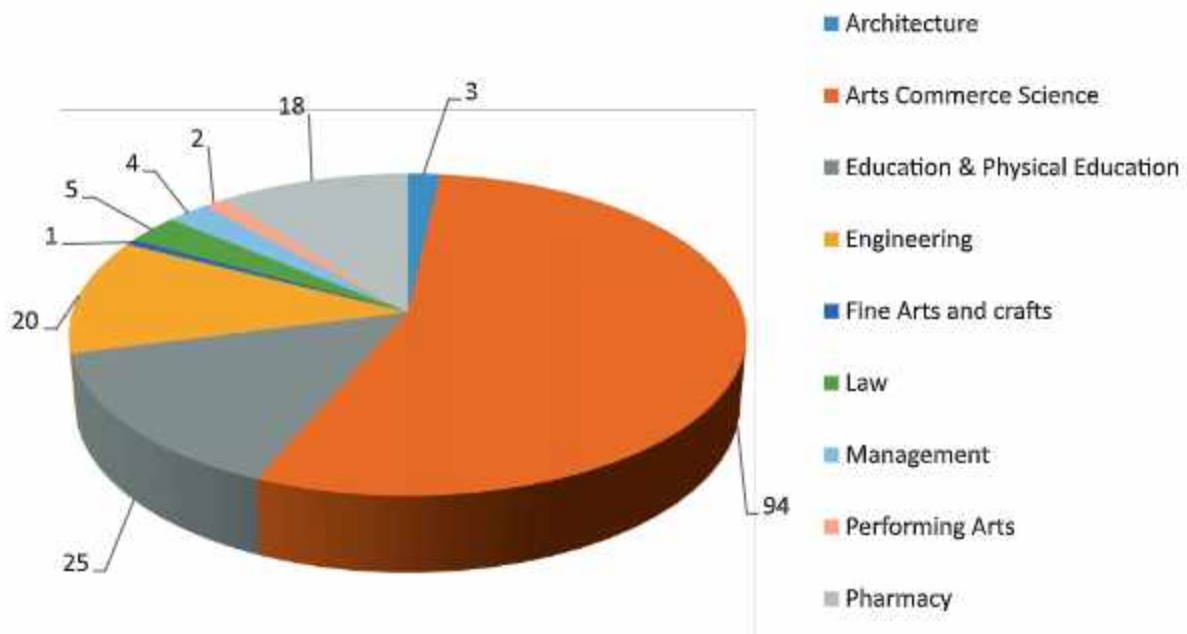

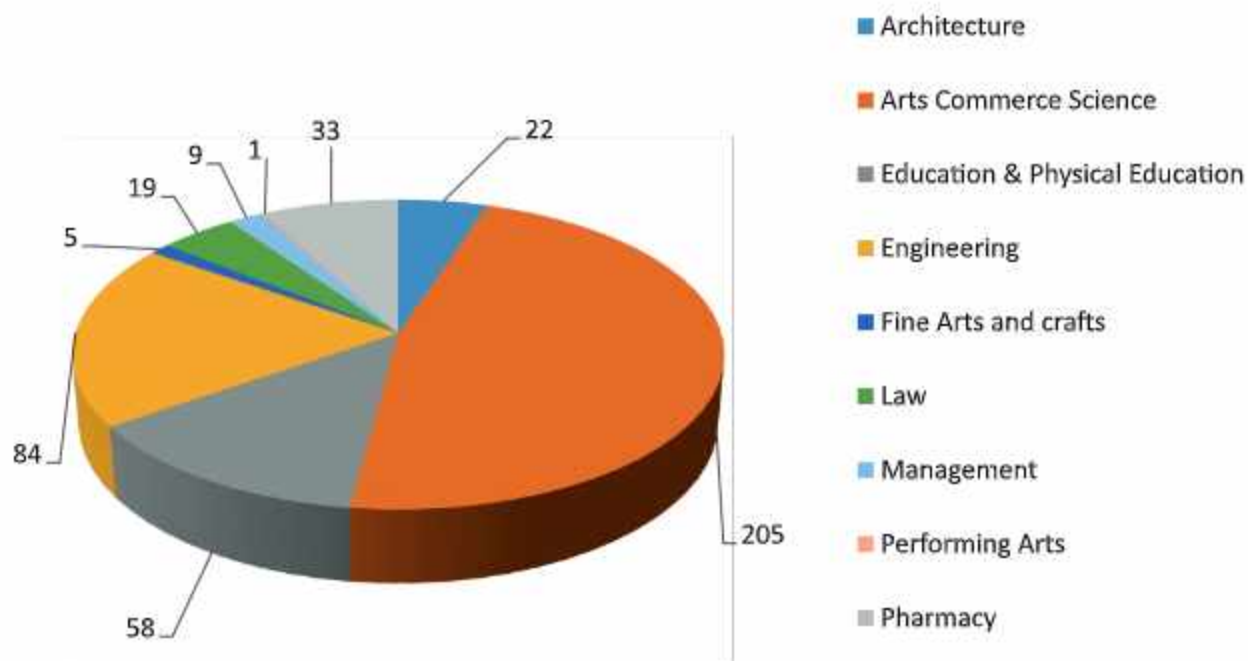
Number of Facultywise Affiliated Colleges in Ahmednagar District



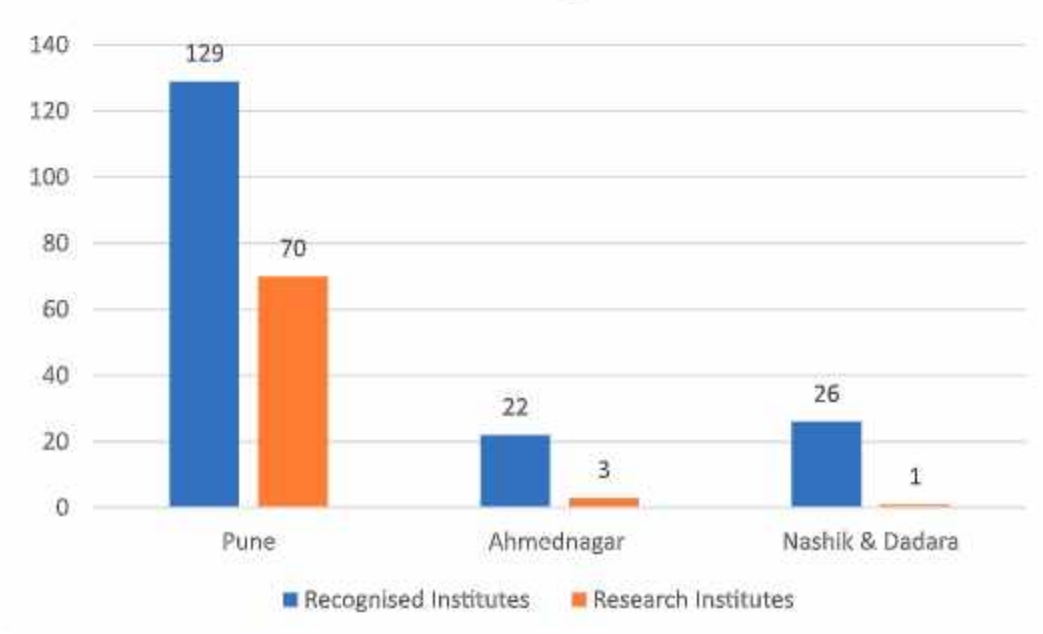
Number of Facultywise Affiliated Colleges in Nashik District



Number of Facultywise Affiliated Colleges in Pune District

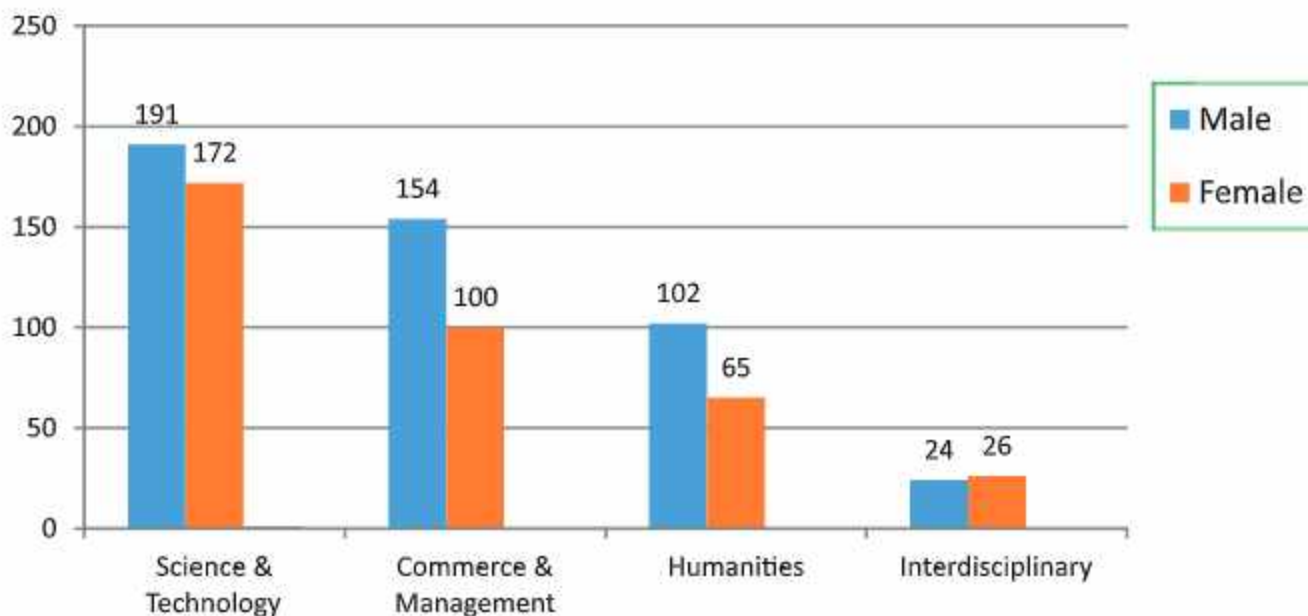

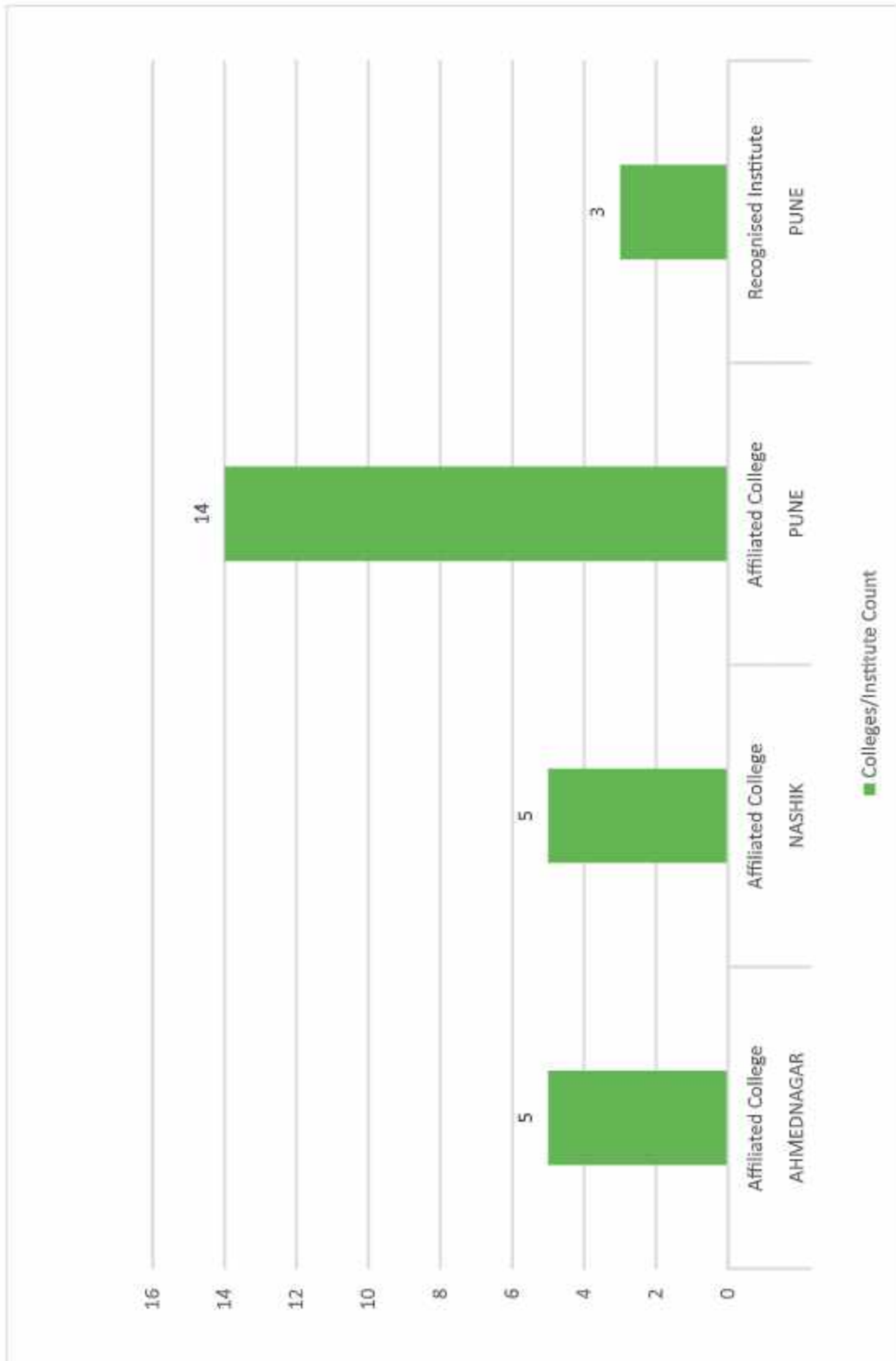

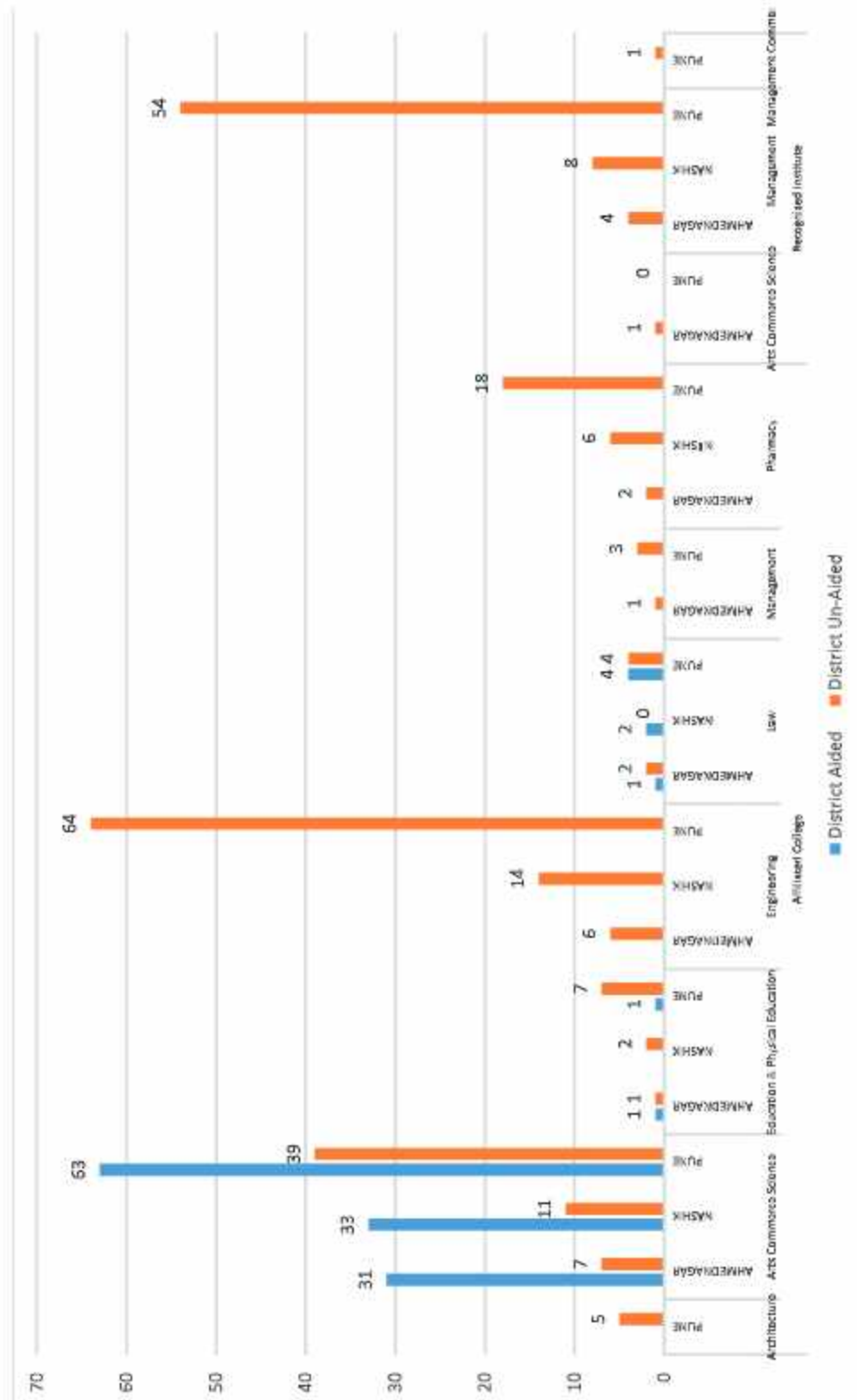

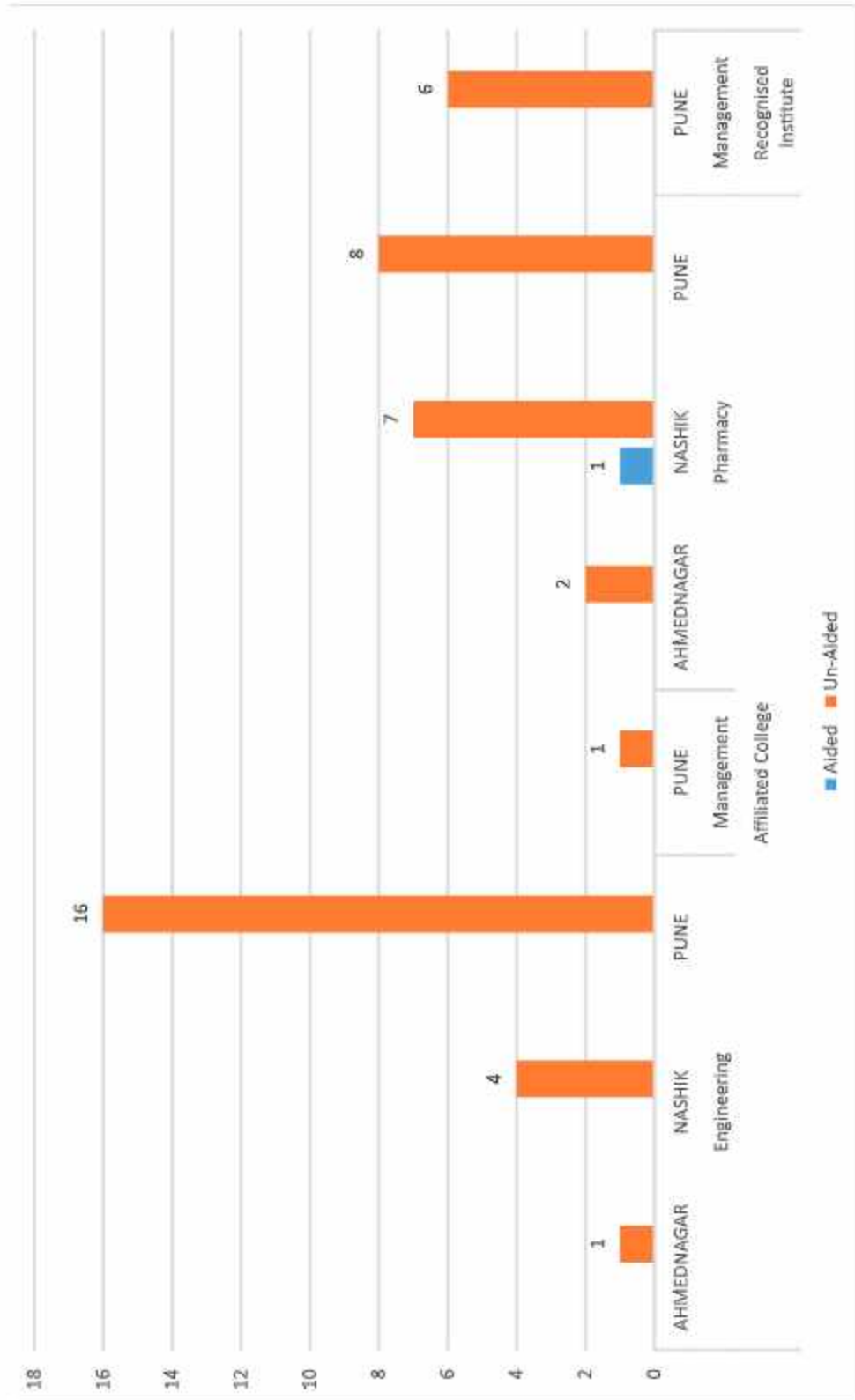


District Wise/Faculty Wise Information of NAAC Accreditation of Colleges, Institutes (Aided/Unaided)

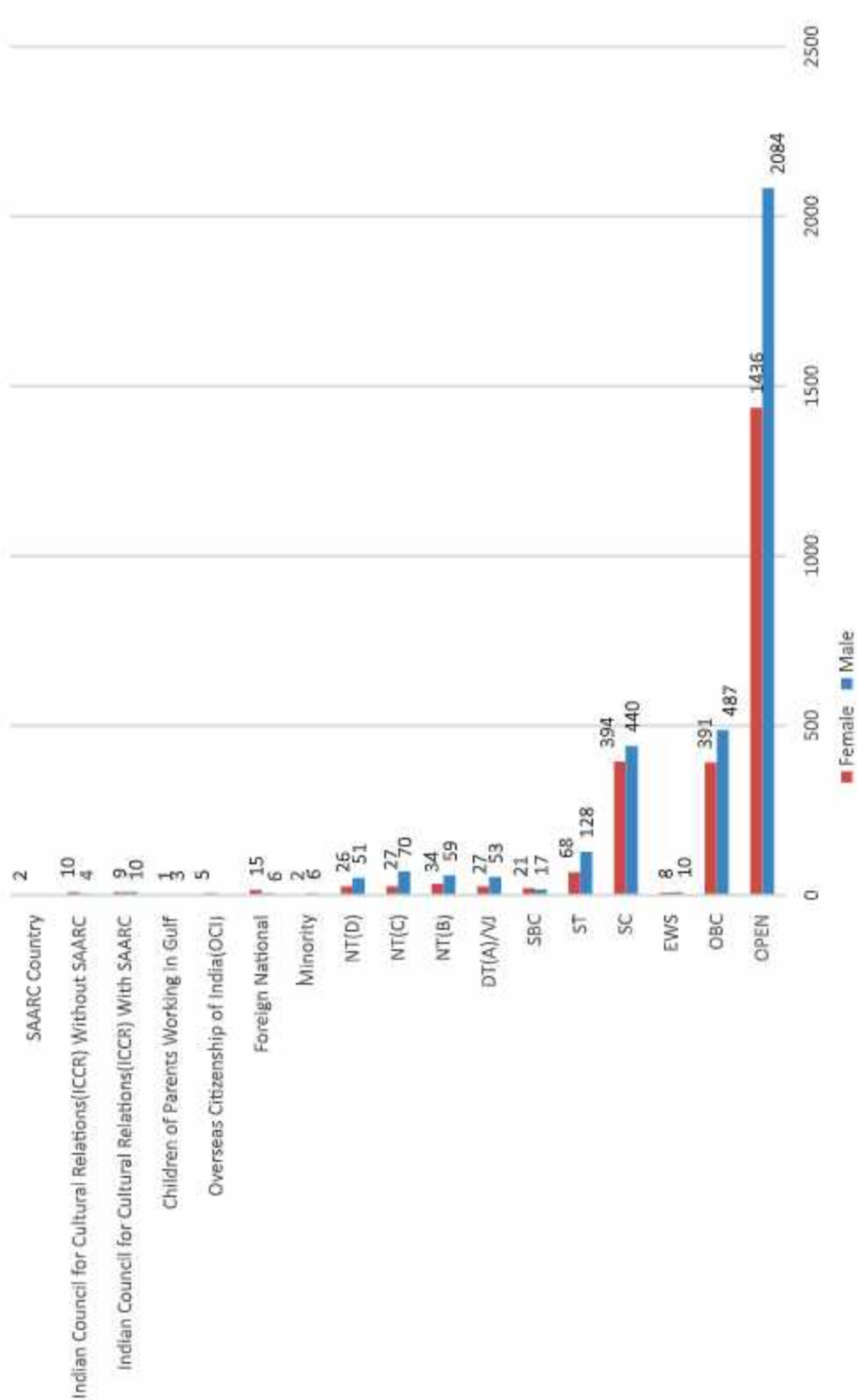




District Wise/Faculty Wise Information of NBA Accreditation of Colleges, Institutes (Aided/Unaided)

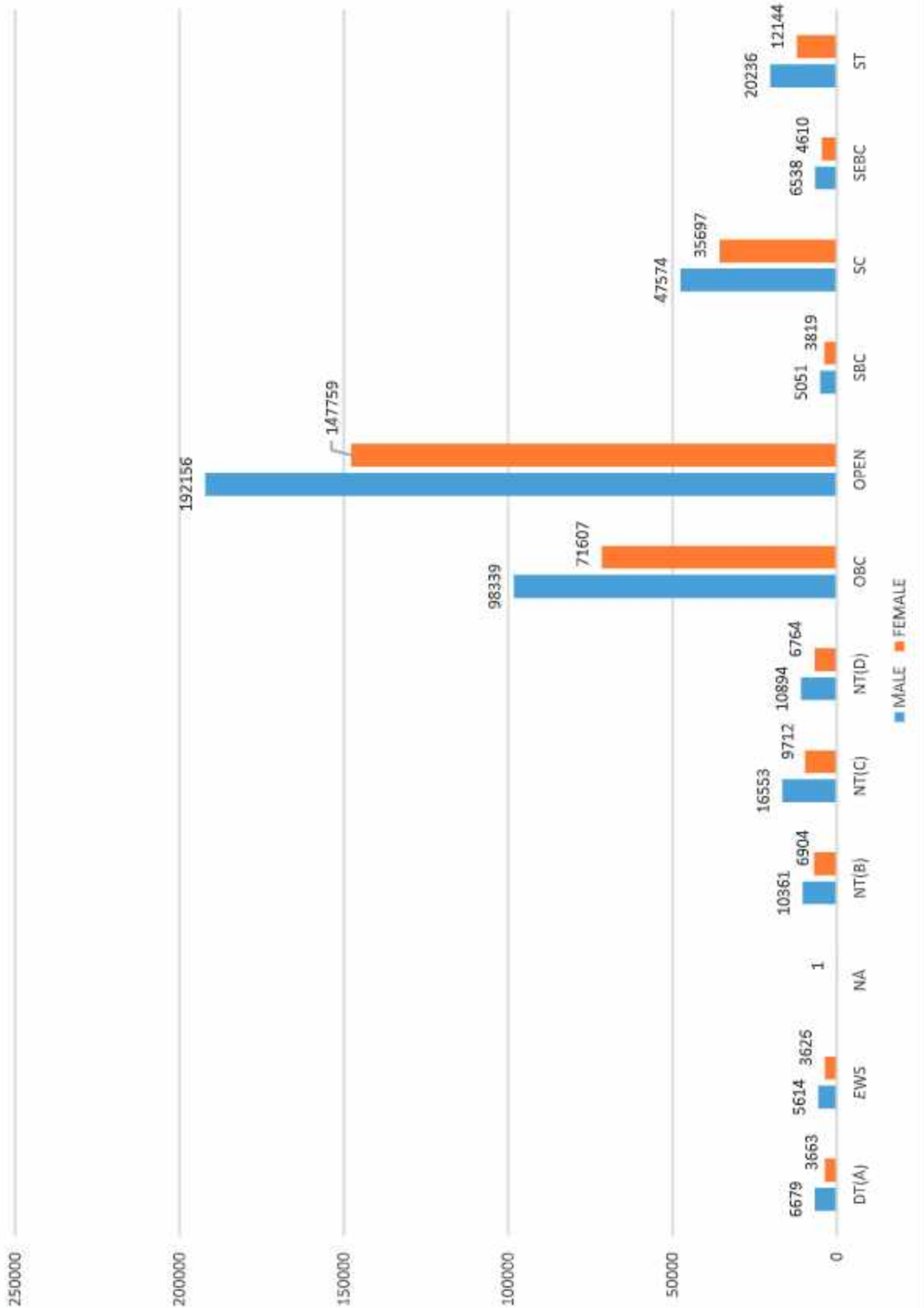


Category wise student count (University Department)



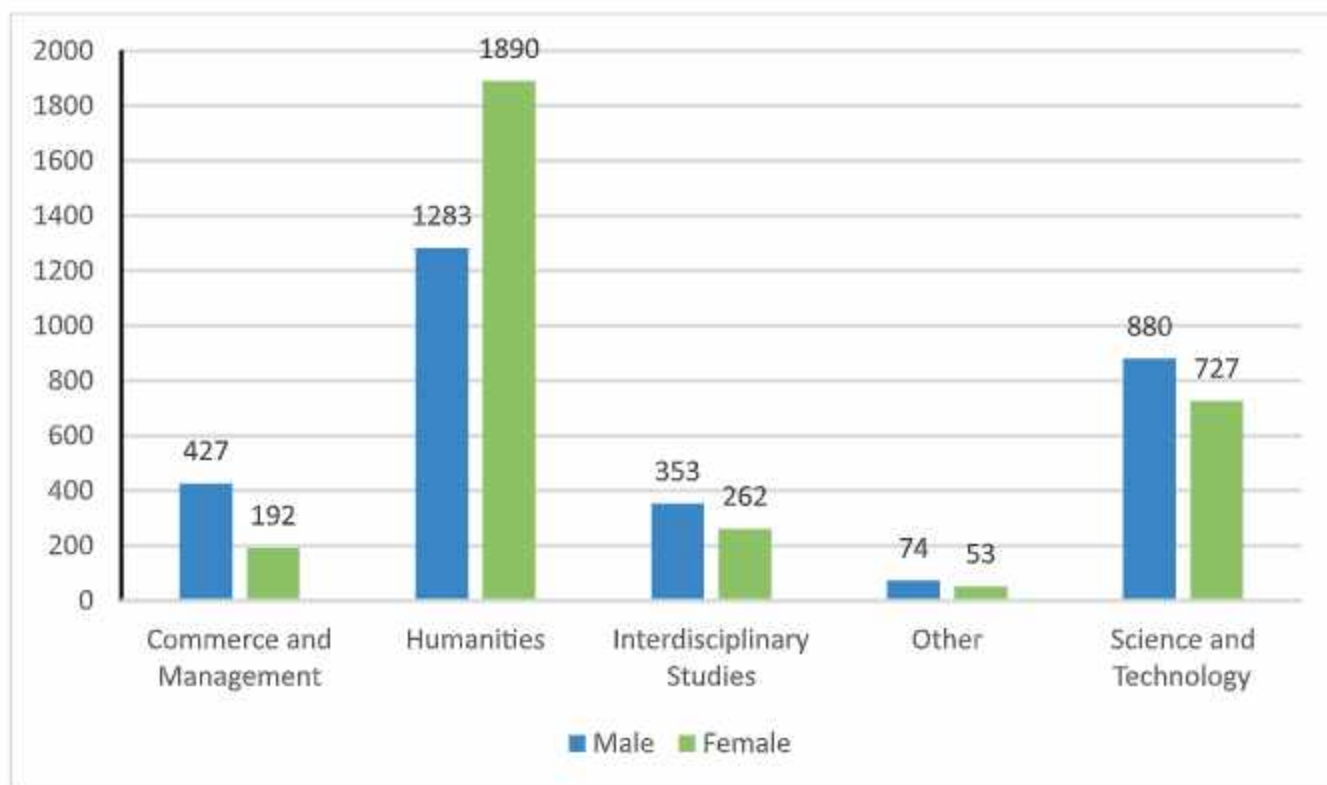


Category wise Student Count (College & Institute)

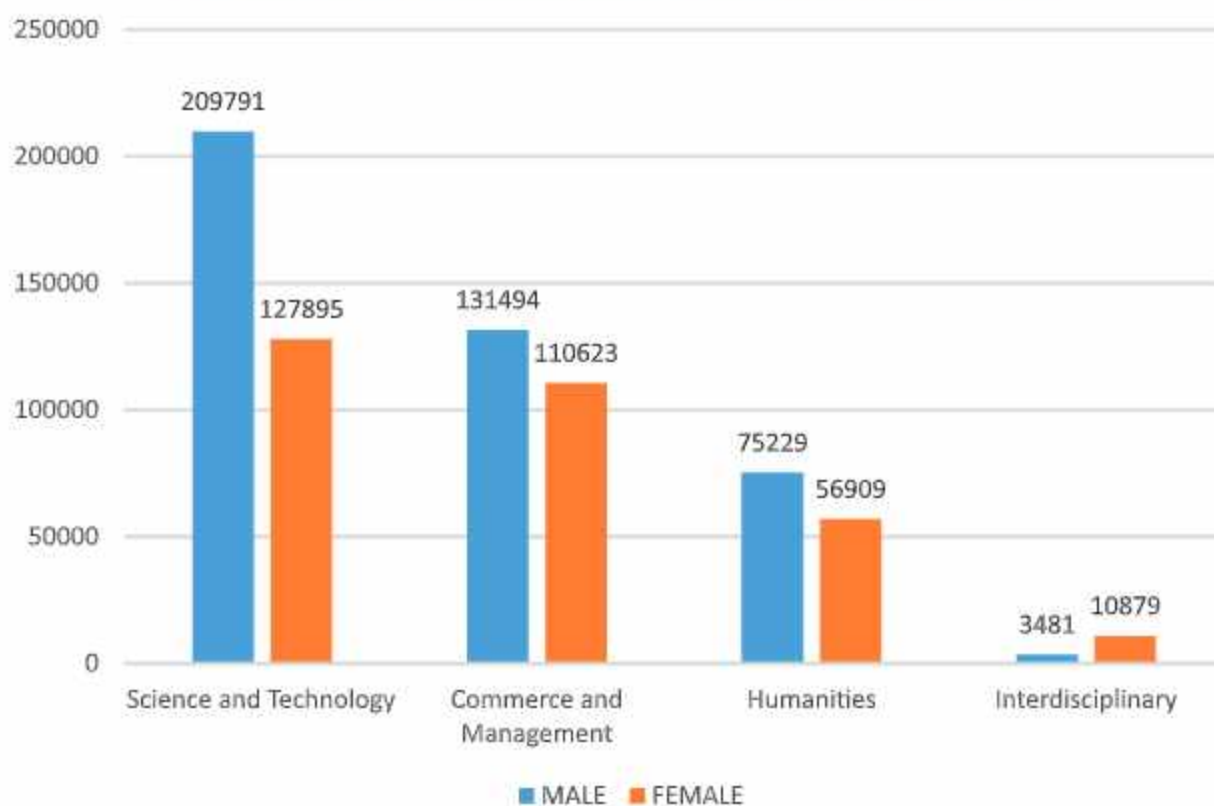




Faculty wise student count (University Department)
